



Industry Obligations

In addition to the mandatory reporting of domestic incidents involving pesticides within prescribed timelines, pesticide registrants must also consider the following compliance obligations:

- **Causality** is **not** a prerequisite for tracking and reporting adverse events associated with the use of pesticides registered with either the EPA or PMRA.
- **FIFRA**: EPA-registered products with like formulations sold in other countries may require that foreign incidents involving these formulations also be reported to the EPA in compliance with FIFRA 6(a)(2).
- **PCPA**: Incidents occurring in the US involving EPA registered products containing active ingredients that are also registered in Canada may require mandatory reporting to the PMRA.

Two important regulations applicable to the Ag-Chem Industry that are a focus of SafetyCall services are highlighted below:

Federal Insecticide, Fungicide & Rodenticide Act (US):

Section 6(a)(2) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) requires pesticide product registrants to submit adverse effects information about their products to the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Registered products include: any substance or mixture of substances intended for preventing, destroying, repelling, or mitigating any pest.

Canadian Pest Control Products Act (Canada):

Pest Control Products Incident Reporting Regulations (SOR/2006-260) requires mandatory reporting of pesticide-related incidents to the Canadian Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA).
